Supple and charming, open-textured and generous, with cherry, plum and orange peel flavors, shaded by a hint of fresh herb as the finish plays against velvety tannins.

14 HANDS Stampede Red

Plush and refreshing, with juicy, cherry-accented blueberry and floral aromas and flavors on a broad frame, coming into focus as the finish lingers against refined tannins. Syrah, Merlot, Viognier, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Mourvèdre.

The building blocks of this blend are always Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Merlot. The remaining varietals are the spices to round and polish the wine. Envision a blueberry, a blackberry and a cherry in a cedar chest. This best describes the nose. Blackberry and ripe black cherry dominate the palate, while a light touch of vanilla bean and cocoa powder round things out. The finish is silky cocoa-cassis that fills the mouth and lasts and lasts.

Firm and chewy, with tobacco and dark berry flavors, persisting into a deftly wrought finish. This has room to flesh out.

Shows the grape's tarter, citrusy side in a lip-smacking way.

ROMBAUER Chardonnay**Carneros 2014****Wine Spectator 88**

Oak, with a creamy vanilla bean and custard character.

SEVEN FALLS Cabernet Sauvignon**Wahluke Slope 2013****Wine Spectator 88**

Firm in texture, this leans toward savory flavors of coffee, tobacco and loamy earth, with dark fruit pushing through on the finish against crunchy tannins.

SOKOL BLOSSER Evolution Big Time Red 4th Edition**America NV****Wine Spectator 87**

Focused, supple and dense, with chocolate-accented plum and spice flavors, echoing against crisp tannins. Sangiovese, Montepulciano, Syrah and others.

SOKOL BLOSSER Lucky No. 9 White 19th Edition**America NV****Wine Spectator 85**

This off-dry white features almond and hazelnut overtones to the modest green pear flavors, finishing with snap. Riesling, Pinot Gris, Sémillon, Müller-Thurgau, Gewürztraminer, Muscat Canelli, and Chardonnay.

SPRING VALLEY Uria**Walla Walla Valley 2013****Wine Spectator 93**

Broad and expressive, playing red plum, black cherry and peppery spice flavors against lightly prickly tannins, coming together on the long and generous finish. Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Malbec, and Cabernet Sauvignon.

TAMARACK Firehouse Red**Columbia Valley 2014***Seattle Magazine "2016 Washington Wine Awards" Winner*

This 2014, featuring a full 10 varieties, is among the most complex, delicious reds produced in Washington for less than \$20.

Ripe, delicious red and black fruits complemented by floral notes and brewed-coffee barrel tones.

Ripe and supple, with plum and berry flavors that mingle with notes of vanilla and root beer on the finish. Shiraz, Durif, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, and Merlot.

Musky, floral and spicy, with candied ginger and pear flavors. Softly juicy, this lingers on the finish.

SPARKLING FOR THE SEASON

Champagne

Sparkling wine exclusively produced in the Champagne region of France, and following rules that demand, among other things, secondary fermentation of the wine in the bottle to create carbonation. Some use the term Champagne as a generic term for sparkling wine, but in most countries it is illegal to officially label any product Champagne unless it both comes from the Champagne region in France and is produced under the rules of the appellation. The United States bans the use from all new U.S. produced wines. Only those that had approval to use the term on labels before 2006 may continue to use it and only when it is accompanied by the wine's actual origin (e.g. "California"). The majority of US-produced sparkling wines do not use the term Champagne on their labels, and some states, such as Oregon, ban producers in their states from using the term.

Sparkling Wine

Sparkling wine is a wine with significant levels of carbon dioxide in it, making it fizzy. The classic example of sparkling wine is Champagne, which is exclusively produced in the Champagne region of France.

Asti Spumante

Asti is a **sparkling white Italian wine**, made from the Moscato Bianco grape. It is sweet and low in alcohol and often served with dessert. Asti is converted to "sparkling" through a process that is different from that of Champagne.

Moscato d' Asti is made in the same region from the same grape, but is only slightly sparkling (frizzante) and tends to have even lower alcohol.

Prosecco

This is an **Italian white wine**, made from the Glera (Prosecco) grape, but may also include, up to 15 percent, various other white grapes, including Chardonnay, Pinot Blanco and Pinot Grigio. Prosecco can be *spumante* (sparkling wine), *frizzante* (semi-sparkling wine) or *tranquillo* (still wine).

Lambrusco

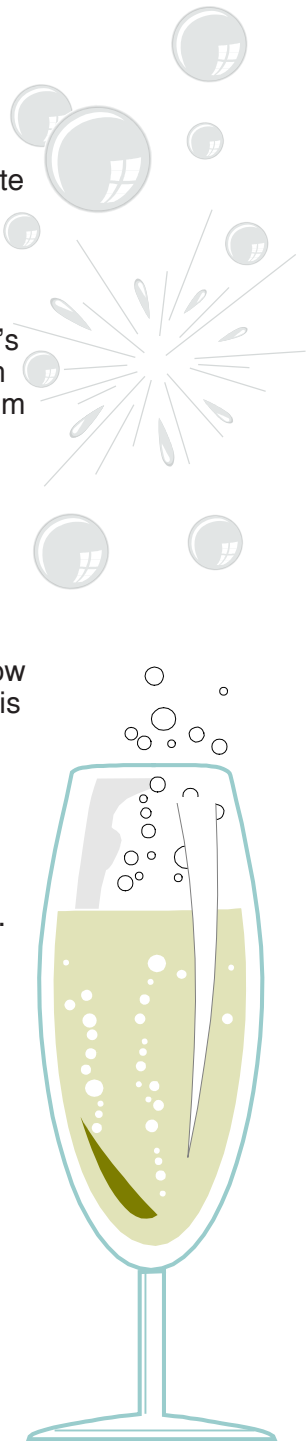
This is the name of both a **red wine grape** and an Italian wine made principally from the grape. The most highly rated of its wines are the *frothy*, *frizzante* (slightly sparkling) red wines.

Sweetness Levels

Brut is a dry style and is the typical style of Champagne with *no sweetness*.

Extra Dry is still dry but with a *hint of sweetness or slightly sweet*.
